General Rules of Election to College Students' Council

As per guidelines provided by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court** regarding Model Code of Conduct for DUSU Elections and the College Staff Council following rules will be implemented in future regarding College Students' Council Elections:

Eligibility Criteria for Contesting Election

1. The candidate must be enrolled in a regular, full-time course of the college.
2. Undergraduate students between 17 and 22 years as on date of election may contest the elections.
3. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
4. The candidate should have attained a minimum of 75% class attendance, excluding ECA attendance.
5. The candidate must have paid all dues towards the college by the date of scrutiny of nomination forms.
6. The candidate shall have only one opportunity in all to contest for the post of office bearer.
7. The candidate should neither have a previous criminal record nor should have been subjected to any disciplinary action by the College/University authorities.
8. The candidate should not possess any other ground which may be deemed as disqualification by the College and Model Code of Conduct of DUSU Election.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTESTING THE COLLEGE STUDENTS COUNCIL ELECTION 2019-20

1. One office out of four - President, Vice-President, Secretary and Joint Secretary is reserved for Girl Students by rotation through draw.
2. The student who has got admission in this College on the basis of Sports, Cultural, NCC, NSS or any other extracurricular activities is not allowed to contest the College Students Union Election 2019-20 for the post of President, Vice President, Secretary and Joint Secretary. However he/she can accept the post of Representative/Secretary of the concerned activity as per the recommendation of the Committee of that concerned activity.
3. The President will be from 3rd year only.
4. The Vice-President/Secretary will be from IInd year or 3rd year only.
5. The Joint Secretary will be from IInd or Ist Year only.
6. A candidate can contest election only for one post.
7. College fee for the year 2019-20 should have been deposited by the contestants before filing their Nomination Form.
8. Students who are not eligible to contest election:-
 - (i) Convicted of a Criminal Offence, (ii) Punished/fined/suspended by University/College for an act of in-discipline, (iii) Involved in Unfair Means in University Examinations.
9. Nomination form shall be verified by the Sr. Asstt. (Admn), Dr. M.P. Singh, Room No. A-4.
10. Attested photocopies of marks sheets of all previous examination from XIIth and onwards should be enclosed with the nomination form. The originals can be asked for by the S.O.(Admn.)/Administrative Officer during verification.
11. Violation of College Election Rules may lead to the cancellation of the candidature of a student.
