Let me now briefly introduce our College.

Our College is a constituent College of University of Delhi. As a co-educational institute, it was established in 1991 in a school building of Geeta Colony to cater the needs of higher education. It is fully funded by the Government of NCT of Delhi In 2001, the College was shifted to the present building, the foundation stone of which was laid by the then Hon'ble Vice-President of India (Hon'ble Sh. K. R. Narayanan Ji). It is spread over 9 acres including a residential area having Principal Bungalow and 12 staff quarters.

With total student strength of about 3809, it has about 130 faculty members including Adhocs and Guests, and the supporting staff comprising 79 members in addition to the few outsourced staff. The College offers a number of professional and honours courses like Business Economics, Hindi Journalism and Mass Communication, Applied Psychology, Social Work, Commerce, Economics, Hindi, Geography and History in addition to B.A. (Prog.), B.Com (Prog.), Political Science, Sanskrit and Urdu as an elective subject. Many new courses are in the pipeline. As per policy of Delhi University, the college has implemented NEP-2020 in this academic session.

Our College also supplements the efforts of the University to serve community by meeting the needs of higher education of the young population. It is one of the Study Centres of the School of Open Learning (SOL) and the Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board for girl students of Delhi (NCWEB, University of Delhi). Dr. Rajbir Vats and Dr.Dhananjay Kumar deserve appreciation as coordinators for these programmes respectively.

The College continues to be one of the 20 Earthquake Strong Ground Motion Stations in Delhi for recording and monitoring earthquakes in Delhi under the project jointly handled by Director of Seismology Division (DST)-DU-IIT (Roorkee).

The College constantly strives to improve its Good Practices, for which 'Special Commendation Prize' was awarded by University of Delhi in 2015. College is NAAC accredited with B+ grade. Now, prepration for the second round of NAAC assessment is in process. Thanks to Prof. Atul Pratap Singh and his team.

Let us quickly review the College activities.

During this year, the College organised/promoted a various extra/co-curricular activities, which are fundamental to human progress and plays a crucial role in the human life.

The College organized orientation programme on 02.11.2022 in physical mode to welcome the newly admitted young students. Dr. Vikas Gupta, Registrar of University of Delhi and Sh. Ankit Singh, IPS (Additional DCP, North-East Delhi) was Chief Guest and Guest of Honour respectively. Thanks to Dr Monica Ahlawat and her team for active support.

Our College is named after Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb, Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar. He was a multi-faceted personality- a great legal luminary known as the Father of the Indian Constitution, a social scientist par excellence, a prolific writer and an editor, a great social reformer and a brilliant orator. In order to acknowledge and create awareness among students and society about his life and mission, academic work and his contribution towards improving the lot of socially disadvantaged sections of population and building a new India based on the principles of justice, liberty, equality and fraternity, the College organises various activities to promote ideas of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Inter-college running trophy 'Chal-Vaijayanti' for debate competition was established in 1991. This year this debate is being organized on 13 February, 2022, and the topic is 'सतत विकास के लिए अनुदान आवश्यक हैं'. The College organises Baba Saheb Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Memorial Lecture Series which was started since 2007 on the occasion of his birth anniversary.

This year, a lecture was organized on the topic "Baba Saheb Dr B. R. Ambedkar: His Life and His Mission" on the occasion of Maha Parinivan Diwas (i.e. 6th December, Lokarpan of Extended Building of Teaching Block and Prize Distribution Function were organized on 22nd December, 2022 in the college auditorium. In this programme Dr. Vinay Sahasrabuddhe (President, Indian Council for Cultural Relations) was Chief Guest and Chief Speaker. Prof Balram Pani (Dean of Colleges) and Prof Shri Prakash Singh (Director, South Campus) also graced the occasion. Thanks to Prof. Mamta and her team.

The College also established Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Study Centre in 2022. The study centre organises various activities and programmes to promote ideas of Baba Saheb. Essay writing competition on 'Role of Baba Saheb Ambedkar on Social Development' was conducted by the Ambedkar Study Circle on 28th January, 2023. A legal awareness session on "Victims of Acid Attack and their Rehabilitation" was organized on 28th January, 2022 in collaboration with North-East District Legal Service Authority. A Debate Competition and drawing competition were conducted on 28th January and 30th January, 2023 respectively. Thanks to Prof. Avtar Singh and his team.

The College recognizes that teaching-learning can be improved by creating a research environment and enhancing writing skills. In order to promote the research activities, the College started an International Multidisciplinary Journal in Social Sciences, Humanities and languages the 'Academia' and published Monographs. In the staff council meeting held on 02.09.2022, editorial board of the 'Academia' restructured. Dr. Narender Thakur and Dr. Bijender Kumar are Editor and Co-Editor of this journal.

With approval of the Governing Body, the College has formed four Centres to enhance innovation, skills and multidisciplinary research in the faculty and students. They are "Centre for Skill Development and Innovation", "Centre for Students' Exchange & Faculty Development Programme Implementation", "Publication and Documentation Centre" and "Centre for Multi-Disciplinary Research"

Prof. Atul Pratap Singh is the convenor of 'The Centre of Skill Development'; Prof R.P. Dwivedi is the Convenor of 'The Centre for Students' Exchange and Faculty Development Programme'; Prof Navin Kumar is the Convenor of 'Publication and Documentation Centre'; and Prof Tushti Bhardwaj is Convenor of 'Center for Multi-Disciplinary Research and Innovation'. The College has introduced three Dr. Ambedkar Innovation Research Project for student of the College with grant of Rs.1.5 lakh. Ten selected students will be given an honorarius of Rs. 1000/- per month for one year. Also three interships for six months in which each student would get Rs.2000/- per month as stipend and a certificate. They will work along with their studies in– (i) Administrative Section; (ii) Accounts Section; (iii) Management of College Campus.

The College has signed a MoU with HallParty for smart Identity card for students which can be used as ATM, Metro/DTC card used along with Identity card of the College. The other MoU has been signed with Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) for BIO Waste Management in the campus. College has also signed a MoU with Kings College, London Cicely Saunders Institute and CanSupport NGO for promoting Research opportunity in the three institutes on 22.12.2022. It has also signed a MoU with Idea Saksham NGO to promote job related opportunities and skill based training to *Divyangjan* students in the college. Rs.1,99,134/- received from BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) in the name of scholarship, 14 students from different departments benefited in this year.

In order to further contribute to the on-going research and putting scholars together working in different research fields while creating awareness among the students and young teachers, the College in association with Environment and Social Development Association (ESDA) facilitated two-day **World Environment Summit 2022** in hybrid mode on 15th-16th october, 2022. Now, The Charge of the Army Wing (Boys) lies in the hands of ANO- Lt Dr. Rajbir Vats with coordination of SUO Varun Sharma. Every year around 37 cadets pass out from NCC 'C' Certificate. Also we enroll 45-50 cadets every year.

Sir, you will be happy to know that our NCC Unit not only helps in nation building, but also makes a positive contribution by facilitating the College administration during admission period and they also help in the maintenance of discipline which is the most difficult task.

The College **Yoga and Gym Society** organises a regular Yoga practice. A three-day Surya Namaskar Session conducted under the aegis of Aazadi ka Amrit Mahotsav Society also celebrated 8th International Yoga-Day on 22nd June 2022. Thanks to the College Team led by Dr. Tulika Sanadhya.

Our College is located in a relatively low socio-economic area of Delhi. Students are encouraged to avail government sponsored Development Schemes and scholarships particularly meant for students belonging to the weaker sections including SC/ST/OBC/PwD/Minorities and others. The College and its **Student Aid and Welfare/Fee Concession Committee** recommend deserving students for financial assistance.

The College recognizes that nature care and environmental education are crucial for sustainable human development and require an inclusive approach. The **Eco-Club** has brought about a noticeable change with its student Team of Green Cadets. These Cadets are committed to community development and love for 'Nature'.

Our **Herbal Park** with more than 110 medicinal plant varieties and Rose Garden with more than 86 plant varieties maintained under the guidance of Eco-Club continue to win top positions in Delhi University Flower Shows every year ever. The college prize score jumped from 2 in 2010 (the year of first time entry) to 14 in 2018. The college has an inventory of about 524 trees (48 varieties), with about 159 plants including Saptapri/*Alstonia scholaris* which are widely known for their anti-pollution qualities.

Students are further encouraged to be eco-friendly and contribute to the college efforts to keep its campus clean and green through its 'Earn while Learn Scheme', the **Eco-Club**, the '**Paper Recycling Unit**' and Gardening. The College functioning,

as we all know, is the coordinated and cooperative effort of all the Administrative Wings, Committees, Departments, faculty and students. The general infrastructure also facilitates the teaching-learning process. Efforts are being made to further improve the existing facilities related to Library, Canteen, Computer Labs (4), Sports Ground and the Air Conditioned Auditorium with a total seating capacity of about 250 persons. It is a matter of satisfaction that the construction of the second floor has been completed. Thanks to the PWD officials.

Our Library with floor wise signages is well equipped with extended facilities like OPAC (through which Registered users can check their library accounts) and N-LIST (E-Journals) of INFLIBNET. Library with 45565 books is computerized and used software and now migrated to KOHA software in the month of December 2022 which would save about 1.5 lakh each year. In last two years, college purchased 4190 new books and subscribed around 54 periodicals (17 English and 14 Hindi) in addition to 23 newspapers (English-08, Hindi-14 and Urdu- 01) on the recommendations of TICs/Library Committee. Special facilities like separate AC Cabin with computer facility, Separate sitting space for reading of Braille study material provided by University of Delhi, and online membership of *Suganya Pustakalaya* are arranged by the library for our *Divyang* students. Special collections of Dr. Ambedkar, Gandhi, Nehru, Dean Dayal Upadhyay and other eminent personalities are also available in the library.

The College thanks all the Committee Convenors and their members who look after management of College administration such as Central Purchases (Dr. Dhananjay Kumar), Stock Verification (Dr. M.S. Kadyan), Academic Development Society for Students (Dr. Narendra Thakur), Central Admissions and Examination (Dr. Ravindra Singh and Prof Jitendra Siroha), Internal Assessment (Dr. M.S. Vats), Computer Lab Development (Dr Ramashray Prasad), Master Time-Table (Dr. K M Bansal), Placement Committee (Dr. Tushti Bhardwaj), Anti-ragging Committee (Dr. Sujit Kumar), Student Aid & Welfare/Fee Consession Committee (Dr. Purushottam), Annual Report Committee (Dr. Ravi Shankar Ravi), Student Discipline (Dr Arvind Kumar) and so on.

Eminent speakers in area of psychology like Prof. Girishwar Mishra, Prof. N K Chadha, Prof. Anand Prakash, Prof. Purnima Singh, Prof. Nandita Babu, Prof. SPK

Jana, Prof. Avinash. Prof. Kumar Ravi Priya, Prof. Bimol Akoijam, Prof. Arvind Mishra, Prof. Kumar Ravi Priya, and Dr. Roma Kumar have been invited on various occasions to enlighten the listeners with their extensive knowledge of the discipline and real life experience. The workshops were conducted to enhance the experiential learning of the participants. The students also actively engaged in different internship programs to get hands on training on various theoretical concepts studied at the department. The practicals designed by the teachers for various papers gave them exposure to diverse research methodology used in psychology that enabled them to write reports in APA format, thus preparing them for publishing papers in reputed journals. In addition, the teachers mentored the students in writing research papers that were presented at national and international conferences. The detailed information of the activities and workshops are as follows:-

- The Department hosted a two day National conference on “Psychology and its Role in Human and Societal Development” on 18th and 19th April 2022. It was followed by a post-conference workshop on “Psychological Research” on 20th April 2022. The conference was graced by the presence of eminent speakers in the field of Psychology from Delhi University, Jawaharlal Nehru University and Indian Institute of Technology like Prof. Girishwar Mishra, Prof. Anand Prakash, Prof. Avinash Kumar, Prof. Purnima Singh, Prof. Nandita Babu, Prof. SPK Jana, Prof. Kumar Ravi Priya, Prof. Bimol Akoijam, Prof. Arvind Mishra and many more. The conference provided a platform to researchers, practitioners and academicians from Psychology and other discipline to meticulously ponder on the issue concerning the individual, society and community as a whole. More than 200 students from across country presented their papers in the conference which helped the students to get an insight of the most relevant researches in the field.
 - The Department of Psychology conducted a departmental activity on slogan writing and poster making on August 10, 2022, in Room 41, under the banner of Har Ghar Tiranga. Students from various departments of the college participated in the event with full enthusiasm and vigor. They highlighted the importance of independence and the commitment they feel for their country.
 - An exclusive workshop on understanding the importance of "Stress Management" was organized by the Department of Psychology, and invited Dr. Roma Kumar as the resource person to conduct this event on 3rd November 2022. It focused on various areas of life such as health, parenting, work, and relationships. Around a hundred participants showed their presence at the event with great zeal. Dr. Roma Kumar, who was also the chief guest of the event, has been the Vice Chairperson at the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioural Sciences at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital. Moreover, she is also the Senior Consultant Psychologist at the Institute of Child Health. She familiarised the audience with several simple and suitable activities that would help cope up with stress and anxiety and followed up her session with an intriguing question-answer round.
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- Most recently the Department conducted an interactive workshop on "Emotional Intelligence" by Prof. N.K. Chadha dated 25th January, 2022. Prof. Chadha is the former Head of the Department of Psychology (University of Delhi), a well known Psychometrician and currently Professor Emeritus at KR Mangalam University. The workshop had lots of fun and introspective exercises which made the students realize the importance, need and ways of developing emotional competence. More than 120 students participated from different departments for the workshop.

In coming months, department has also lined up other interdisciplinary seminars for the advancement of students.

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12.12 Department of Social Work (Dr. Sangeeta Sharma Dhaor, TIC)

The Department organised a three days intensive orientation programme for the B.A (H) Social Work Ist year students from 20th-22th July 2022. In the Orientation Programme on the first day 20th July 2022, Dr Sanjeev Sheel (Executive Director Anchal Charitable Trust), Mr. Tony Bansal (Sathi Foundation). Sensitivity was developed among students about Green Social work to work with communities towards environment protection. Life Skill Education was imparted to students for positive behaviour that enables them to adjust to demand and challenges of life. In

the orientation programme on the second day, 21st July 2022, Prof. Avtar Singh (Department of Social Work, BRAC), Ms. Charu Kapoor Makkar (Member, Juvenile Justice Board), Ms. Ashni Dhaor (Principal Correspondent, Hindustan Times) Students were given knowledge on Environmental rights. Students learnt about the Juvenile Justice Act and its implementation in terms of practices and issues of child rights legislations. Students were given information and insights on role of media in achieving social justice. On the third day of the orientation programme, 22nd July 2022, Mr. Manish Vyomini (Milestones) and Ms. Swati Solanki (ONGC) interacted with our students. Students were guided on the community preparedness and process to learn about the Do's and Don'ts of working in the community. Students were given insights on the emerging issues to understand the practice of Corporate Social Responsibility in corporate house and Ideas of resource mobilization. In addition, Special Interactive session of faculty members of the Department of Social Work and Principal was organized with students to welcome the new students and introduced them to Department activities, Course, administrative framework and to respond students enquires. The first year students who have taken admission in the year 2022-23 were oriented about the course structure, NEP and fieldwork requirements and expectations. STUDENTS COUNSELLING COMMITTEE

Faculty members like Dr Anita Srivastava, Dr. Tulika Sanadhya, Dr. N. Victoria, Dr. Dilijeet Kaur, Dr. Neha Arora, Dr. Nisha Chaudhary, Dr Ritu Agarwal, Dr. Rajbala Gautam, Dr. Anil and many more.

The resource persons in the workshop emphasized the importance of suicide prevention through a variety of activities. These activities aimed to educate attendees on the warning signs of suicide, how to have a conversation with someone who may be at risk, and how to access resources for help. The College is fully equipped with IT facilities including four computer labs, Internet access and multimedia projectors with interactive smart board. The college has high-speed Internet connectivity with 125 Mbps fiber optics provided by the University of Delhi and Airtel 4G Home WiFi connections for an official emergency etc.

Computer Labs are equipped with 10 (Ten) 5KVA and 2 (Two) 10KVA online UPS facilities with 1hrs power backup. The entire college campus is Wi-Fi enabled with UTM Box security system. The entire college campus is covered by 62 CCTV camera networks and the Library has 26 network cameras for security of students, staff and the college with separate surveillance room.

The college has established an IT Hub including 110 computers and 02 servers with the latest configuration. The Computer labs I, II, III, and IV are equipped with Smart Board for teaching and learning of students. The college received 813 laptops for

students and 20 laptops for teachers from the University of Delhi, which were subsequently distributed to the students and faculty members for their academic practical etc. To improve IT infrastructure and teaching methodology, the College has installed 22 multimedia projectors provided by Delhi University in the classrooms with an equal number of laptops to teach students through it. The college is currently in the process of making its students attendance system online.
