## **A BRIEF INTRODUCTION ABOUT OUR COLLEGE**

### **Let me briefly introduce our college**

Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar College came into existence in the year 1991 during the birth centenary year of Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb Dr. Bhim Rao Ramji Ambedkar. It celebrated its Silver Jubilee in the year 2016. It is a constituent co-educational college of the University of Delhi and 100% funded by the Delhi Government. Over the years, our college has become an important institution of learning and knowledge, Cultural and Sports activities.

It has an excellent infrastructure including a library, an auditorium, a health center, a spacious canteen, a bank with ATM, etc. The entire campus is under CCTV surveillance system with 96 cameras. It offers a range of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities that encourage to participate. Some of the unique student-friendly programs of the College include Yoga and meditation space, Open Gymnasium, Reflexology Path, Paper Recycling Unit, Cricket Academy and so on, which provide an atmosphere to facilitate holistic development and equip all students with the necessary life skills. The college has excellent human resources regarding qualified teachers and trained office staff.

The college holds the unique distinction of being the forerunner in launching four professional courses of the University namely:

B.A. (Hons.) Hindi Journalism and Mass Communication was introduced in 1994-95,

B.A. (Hons.) Social Work and B.A. (Hons.) Business Economics were started in 1995-96 and

B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology was introduced in 2007- 08.

The college has the distinction of offering some Commerce courses like Human Resource Management (HRM) and Office Management and Secretarial Practice (OMSP). Apart from these courses, the College offers honours courses in Commerce, Economics, Geography, Hindi and History in addition to B.A. Programme in Political, Sanskrit, Urdu etc. As per policy of Delhi University, College has implemented NEP 2020 and offered 18 and 17 courses for VAC and SEC respectively.

At BRAC, we prioritize classroom teaching and pedagogical innovation to provide an academically sound education. Our dedicated faculty members are committed to staying abreast of the latest developments in their respective fields, ensuring that our curriculum remains relevant and up to date. We foster an environment that encourages research, development, and innovation, extending learning beyond the confines of the classroom.

The College is quite sensitive to the needs of PwD students. Barcode signages have been fixed in front of each class room and administrative sections for visually impaired students.

Three other Centres are running in our college:

- School of Open Learning (SOL)

The college has taken an initiative to start a *Centre for Multidisciplinary Research, Centre for Innovation and Skill Development, Faculty Development and Students exchange programmes with different Universities and Colleges of the country.*

The college motto, 'Atto Deepo Bhava' which means 'Be your light', motivates all to work hard with dedication and integrity, to enlighten ourselves and contribute to society's welfare while driving strength from the teachings of Baba Saheb who saw education as a potent tool which could equally empower every citizen. It has total student strength of 3768, it has 147 faculty members including Ad-hocs and Guests, and 79 supporting staff members in addition to the few outsourced staff.

We have **7 International students from Japan, Bangladesh, Indonesia, Mongolia, and Ethiopia.** The Foreign Student's Advisory Committee is looking after the international students. Thanks to Prof. Navin Kumar.

#### **College Orientation Programme 2023-24:**

The college organized an orientation programme for the newly admitted students on 16th August 2023 in the college premises. The programme was attended by the students and their parents. Prof. R.B. The College is fully equipped with IT facilities including four computer labs, Internet access and multimedia projectors with interactive smart board. The college has high-speed Internet connectivity with 200 Mbps fiber optics provided by the University of Delhi and Airtel 4G Home WiFi connections for official emergency uses. Computer Labs are equipped with 5KVA x 3; 10 KVA x 1 and 1 KVA online UPS with 1hrs power backup. To make the entire college campus Wi-Fi enabled for Students and staff is under process (As standby 3 wifi router is installed in Admin Block and Media Block respectively for official uses).

The entire college campus is covered by 64 CCTV camera networks and the library has 32 network cameras for security of students, staff, and the college with separate secured surveillance rooms. The college has established an IT Hub including 110 computers and 02 servers with the latest configuration.

Computer labs I, II, III, and IV are equipped with Smart Board for teaching and learning of students. The college received 813 laptops for students and 20 laptops for teachers from the University of Delhi, which were subsequently distributed to the students and faculty members for their academic practicals etc.

To improve IT infrastructure and teaching methodology, the College has installed 22 multimedia projectors provided by Delhi University in the classrooms with an equal number
