Let me now briefly introduce our College.

Our College is a constituent College of the University of Delhi. As a co-educational institute, it was established by the Government of NCT of Delhi in 1991 to cater to the needs of higher education in a school building in Geeta Colony, East Delhi. In 2001, the College shifted to the present building, the foundation stone of which was laid by the then Hon'ble Vice-President of India (Hon'ble Sh. K. R. Narayanan Ji). It is spread over 9 acres including a residential area having 12 staff quarters and Principal's bungalow.

With a total student strength of about 3409 (1% extra concession in the cut-off for girl students), it has got about 136 faculty members including Adhocs and Guests, and the supporting staff comprises 79 members in addition to the few outsourced staff. The College offers many professional and honours courses like Business Economics, Hindi Journalism and Mass Communication, Applied Psychology, Social Work, Commerce, Economics, Hindi, Geography and History in addition to B.A. (Programme), B.Com, Sanskrit and Urdu as an elective subject. Three other courses are in the pipeline. The College is privileged to have WUS Health Centre on its premises to look after the healthcare needs of College students and the staff of the University of Delhi. Very soon, the College may see the completion of its Print

Media, Radio Recording and community Radio Station Labs. Thanks to Dr. Shashi and her Team.

Our College also supplements the efforts of the University and serves the community by meeting the needs of higher education for the young population. It is one of the Regional-cum-Study Centres of the School of Open Learning (SOL) for boys and girls and the Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board for girl students of Delhi (NCWEB, University of Delhi). Dr. Arvind Kumar and Dr. Dhananjay Kumar deserve appreciation as coordinators of these programmes.

The College continues to be one of the 20 Earthquake Strong Ground Motion Stations in Delhi for recording and monitoring earthquakes in Delhi under the project jointly handled by the Director of Seismology Division (DST)-DU-IIT Roorkee.

The College constantly strives to improve its Good Practices, for which the 'Special Commendation Prize' was awarded by the University of Delhi in 2015. The College has registered well in time and much ahead of others with GeM for general purchases and PFMS for government grants. College is NAAC accredited with a B+ grade.

Let us quickly review the College activities.

At the outset, let me underline that despite the challenges posed by the unfortunate situation created by the pandemic COVID-19, the College not only carried out all its activities with the help of teaching and non-teaching staff but also contributed to the mitigation of COVID-19-induced pains by facilitating the efforts of the GNCTD by sharing the social responsibility. Our College was made a 'Food Distribution and Hunger Centre' during the nationwide lockdown wherein a few hundred persons were offered food twice a day. It is still the COVID-19 Isolation Centre.

During this year, the College organised/promoted various extra/co-curricular activities, which are fundamental to human progress and plays a crucial role in human life.

The College organized an orientation programme on 22nd November, 2021 in blended mode to welcome the newly admitted young students. Thanks to Prof. Balram Pani, Dean of Colleges, University of Delhi and Shri. Dependra Pathak, IPS, Special CP, Law and Order for sparing their precious time. Thanks to Dr Sarla Bhardwaj, Dr Nalin Kumar Dr. M.S. Vats, Dr. Narender Thakur, Dr. S.S.Chawla, Dr. Rajbir Vats, Dr. K.K.Sharma, Dr. Tulika Sanadhya, Dr. Arvind Kumar Yadav, Ms. Victoria Chanu, Dr. Ravindra Singh, Mr. Kumar Satyam, Dr. Venu Gopal, Dr. Vinod, Dr. Jitendra, Mr. Rohit Kumar and Dr. Neha Sharma for their active support.

Our College is named after Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb, and Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar. He was a multi-faceted personality - a great legal luminary known as the Father of the Indian Constitution, a social scientist par excellence, a prolific writer and an editor, a great social reformer and a brilliant orator. To acknowledge and create

awareness among students and society about his life and mission, academic work and his contribution towards improving a lot of socially disadvantaged sections of the population and building a new India based on the principles of justice, liberty, equality and fraternity, the College started Baba Saheb Bhim Rao Ambedkar Memorial Lecture Series in 2007 on the occasion of his birth anniversary. Since then, it has been continuing.

The first Baba Saheb Memorial lecture was delivered by Prof. Namvar Singh on 14th April 2007. An event was organized on the topic “Contribution of Baba Saheb Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar in Nation Building” on the occasion of Maha Parinivan Diwas of Dr. Ambedkar on 6th December 2021 at the college auditorium. In this programme, Hon’able Shri Indresh Kumar, Patron, Samrasta Manch was the Chief Guest. Prof. Balram Pani (Dean of Colleges) and Prof. A.K. Bhagi (President, DUTA) also graced the occasion. Thanks to the College Dr. Rajesh Upadhaya, Dr. Arvind Kumar Yadav and his Team.

The College also pays homage to Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb Dr Bhim Rao Ambedkar on the occasion of the Maha Parinirvaan Divas (6th December). The life, achievements and contributions of Baba Saheb were recalled by organizing an Intra-College speech contest. Thanks to Dr. Diljeet and her Team.

Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat initiative of the Government of India aims to strengthen the unity and integrity of India and enhance understanding and bonding between States and UTs through the exchange of cultural knowledge, traditions and practices. The National Capital Territory of Delhi was earmarked as a partner State along with the seven North Eastern states. The College *Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat* Club organized a Curiosity Quiz Contest based on a virtual tour of Sikkim on 14th August, 2021 in which 23 students from various departments participated in the competition and the winners of the contest were Manish Kashyap (1st Prize), Gracy (2nd Prize) and Akshay Malhotra (3rd Prize). You will be pleased to know that ours is probably one of the very few Colleges, wherein young students are encouraged to cultivate Research inclination. As a result, students of the Department of Business Economics (Aastha Bansal, Harshita khaneja, Nitin khaneja Uttara Bhardwaj) contributed about 6 research papers and articles in various UGC listed National and International Journals.

To further contribute to the ongoing research and put scholars together working in different research fields while creating awareness among the students and young teachers, the College as a Partner to Environment and Social Development Association (ESDA) organized a three-day (online) conference on the occasion of World Environment Summit 2021 (1-3 October, 2021). Our College Medical Committee with the Department of Social Work organised a Webinar on "Post Covid Complications" (2nd September, 2021). A series of webinars were organised as part of the series on Health Awareness - Webinar on “Women Health - Facts and Common Problems” (7th October, 2021), Webinar on “Hair Care” (18th October, 2021) and another Webinar on the topic “Current

Challenges” (25th October, 2021). More than 270 teachers from different Universities in India participated and appreciated these programs. Within our constraints, we also work towards nation-building through our NSS and NCC units.

The College NSS unit has about 250 active volunteers and is working towards bringing change in society and in inculcating among youth a sense of responsibility towards society and developing the spirit of unity, harmony and personality development in student volunteers through community interaction. The volunteers with their Office Bearers; Shivansh Tripathi (Coordinator) along with Sarik Ahamad, Aditya Pandey, Vishakha Panchal etc. are involved in various other events and competitions, such as - awareness programmes, cleanliness drives, educating underprivileged children, community services, etc. The NSS unit of our college is divided into five teams named ‘Team Paathashaala’, ‘Green and Clean Squad’, ‘Divyaang Sahayak team’, ‘Content Writing Team’ and ‘Media Team’. The College NSS Team led by NSS Programme Officer Dr. Sarla Bhardwaj along with Dr. Venu Gopal and Student Coordinator Shivansh Tripathi deserve appreciation.

The College NCC unit (now having about 338 cadets) was started in 1993 under the guidance of Major (Dr.) M. S. Vats. It has two Army Wings (one each for boys and girls), a Naval Wing and an Air Wing (registered at 1 Delhi Air Sqn, C Group). With 128 cadets in the Army Boys Wing and 160 Cadets in Army Girls Wing, the College NCC is well acknowledged not only in the University but also in the Army units. Like every year, our cadets got selected in various camps such as Republic Day Camp, National Integration Camp, Thal Sainik Camp, PM Rally, Mountaineering, Amar Jawan Jyoti, Youth Exchange Programme, Trekking, IMA etc. The social service activities involve Tree Plantation, Blood Donation, Community Development Program, Adult Education Awareness about Non Curable Diseases, Eye Donation and Anti Dowry Pledge, Assistance in Traffic Control, Construction of Bridges, Repair of Roads, Anti-Tobacco Campaign, Anti Leprosy Program, Environment Awareness Program and Motivational Talks, Lifesaving Courses. Now, The Charge of the Army Wing (Boys) lies in the hands of ANO- Lt Dr. Rajbir Vats with the coordination of SUO Kunal. Every year around 30 cadets pass out from NCC ‘C’ Certificate. Also, we enrol 45- 50 cadets every year.

Let us recall the 26th January, 2022. Keeping up the old tradition of the College, our students represented the College in the Republic Day Camp 2022 and participated in

the Rajpath Marching Contingent (20th December, 2021 - 30th January, 2022). Cdt Ruchi Jha participated in a Ship Modelling event carried out by 2 Delhi Naval Unit, Okhla where she made a solid model of INS Talwar and a Working Model of INS Kolkata from 28th December, 2021 to 15th January, 2022. Cdt Shivampal and Cdt Jugal Panchariya got selected for the Prime Minister's Rally Camp 2022 from 11th January to 29th January, 2022. PO Cdt Kanchan Mishra participated in Annual Training Camp 2022 held at Indian Naval Academy Ezhimala, Kerala from 05 January to 22nd January, 2022. Leading Cadet Charu Singh took part in PM Rally Tableaus 2022 at Cariappa Parade Ground Delhi Can from 13th January to 29th January, 2022. Congrats and thanks to the NCC Officers SLT. (Dr.) Arvind Kumar Yadav, LT. (Dr.) Rajbir Vats and Dr. Anju.

Our NCC (Army, Girls Wing) has become very popular over the period. Presently we have an enrolment of 160 girl cadets comprising 50 cadets from 1st year, 56 cadets from 2nd year and 54 cadets from 3rd year from different courses with Rekha Kumari Mandal as SUO and Kamyia Paliwal as JUO. 40 cadets have given the C certificate and 30 cadets have given the B certificate exam this year. Like every year, our cadets got selected in various camps like Republic Day Camp, National Integration Camp, Thal- Sainik Camp, PM Rally, Mountaineering, Amar Jawan Jyoti, Youth Exchange Programme, Trekking, IMA etc.

Our NCC Naval Wing NCC Naval Wing started in the year 1991 in our College in the guidance of Principal then Dr. R.B. Solanki. Today we have 50 cadets who are getting training under Associate NCC Officer Sub/Lt. (Dr.) Arvind Kumar Yadav and Senior Cadet Captain Shivangi Bhatt of B.A. History (H) 3rd year. This year also our Cadets have performed excellently in different camps and various activities from College level to National level.

Sir, you will be happy to know that our NCC Unit not only helps in nation building but also makes a positive contribution by facilitating the College administration, particularly during the admission period as and when required particularly in the maintenance of discipline which is the most difficult task.

Further, ever since (2015) our College was nominated by GNCTD and the NCC Unit 2 Delhi Girls Battalion as the Nodal Agency to organize a Mega Event to popularize Yoga on the occasion of International Yoga Day (21st June), we have been continuing with Yoga Training of students. The College Yoga Committee organised a regular Yoga practice online from 17th to 20th June, 2021 from 7:30 AM to 8:15 AM. The International Day of Yoga was organised online on the theme Be with Yoga, Be at Home (21st June, 2021). Thanks to the Resource person and the College Team led by Dr Sanggeta Sharma, Dr. Rajbir Vats, Dr. K. K. Sharma, Dr. Ritu Aggarwal, Dr. Mitu Dash, Mr. Kumar Satyam, Dr. Rajbala Gauttam, Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, Dr. Rohit Kumar and Dr. Anuradha Tyagi.

Given that our College is located in a relatively low economic profile area of Delhi, the requirements of our heterogeneous group of students are different from those of other colleges. Students are encouraged to avail government-sponsored

Development Schemes and scholarships particularly meant for students belonging to the weaker sections including SC/ST/OBC/PwD/Minorities and others. The College and its Welfare/Fee Committee recommend some students for financial assistance.

The College recognizes that nature care and environmental education are crucial for sustainable human development and require an inclusive approach. The Eco-Club constituted under the guidance of Dr. R.N. Dubey in 2006 has brought about a noticeable change with its student team. These students combine the discipline of NCC, a commitment to improve the natural environment of the campus and its surrounding area.

Our Herbal Park with more than 110 medicinal plant varieties and Rose Garden with more than 86 plant varieties maintained under the guidance of Eco-Club continue to win top positions in Delhi University Flower Shows every year ever since we started participating in 2010. The college prize score jumped from 2 in 2010 (the year of first-time entry) to 14 in 2018. The college has an inventory of about 524 trees (48 varieties), with about 159 plants including Saptapri/Alstonia scholaris which are widely known for their anti-pollution qualities.

Students are further encouraged to be eco-friendly and contribute to the college's efforts to keep its campus clean and green through its 'Earn While Learn Scheme', the Eco-Club, the 'Paper Recycling Unit' and Gardening. The College functioning, as we all know, is the coordinated and cooperative effort of all the Administrative Wings, Committees, Departments, faculty and even students. The general infrastructure also facilitates the teaching-learning process. Efforts are being made to further improve the existing facilities related to the Library, Canteen, Computer Labs (4), Sports Ground and the Air Conditioned Auditorium with a total seating capacity of about 250 persons. It is a matter of satisfaction that the construction of the second floor in the Academic Block has been completed. Thanks to the PWD officials.

Our Library with floor-wise signages is well equipped (books, approx. 41,399) with extended facilities like OPAC (through which Registered users can check their library accounts) and N-LIST (E-Journals) of INFLIBNET. The library is computerized and uses Libsys software. This year the college has added 498 new books and subscribed to around 54 periodicals (17 English and 14 Hindi) in addition to 23 newspapers (English-08, Hindi-14 and Urdu- 01) on the recommendations of the TICs/Library Committee. The meritorious and economically weaker students are provided books under the SAF scheme. Special facilities like a separate AC Cabin with a computer facility, a Separate sitting space for reading Braille study material provided by the University of Delhi, and online membership of Sugamya Pustakalaya are arranged by the library for our *divyang* students. The library is under the surveillance of CCTV. Special collections of Dr. Ambedkar, Gandhi, Nehru and other eminent personalities are also available in the library.

The College thanks all the Committee Convenors and their members who look after Central Purchases (Dr. Purshottam), Stock Verification (Dr. Rajesh Upadhyay),

College Development and Welfare (Dr. Lalit Kumar), Admissions and Examinations (Dr. Nalin Kumar, Dr. Narender Thankur, Dr. M. S. Vats), Internal Assessment (Dr. M.S. Vats), Computer Lab Development (Mr. Purshottam and Dr. B. M. Dash), Master Time-Table (Dr. Sarla Bhardwaj), Placement Committee (Dr. Lalit Kumar), Anti-ragging Committee (Dr. Sanjay Sharma), Student Welfare/Fee Concession Committee (Dr. Purushottam), Annual Report Committee (Dr. M.S. Vats & Dr. Indiar Mishra) and so on.

The promotion of extra-curricular and co-curricular activities for students is equally important during their studies. The respective College Departments, Societies and Committees organize such activities and programmes.

It is heartening to note that despite the COVID-19 crisis, the Placement Cell organised placement drives and around 49 students found placements in 18 companies. Many companies are going to come during the next few months. Students placed with the highest package were offered Rs.7.1 lakh per annum and the average salary per annum was 4.02 lakh.

The Department of Business Economics organised many events and programs during the celebration year of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. In this series, an “Online Quiz Contest” was organised on 28th June 2021 on the occasion of the celebration of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. A Debate Competition on 8th July, 2021 and a Poster Competition on 19th July, 2021 were organised on the theme Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. Department of Business economics organised a student-centric program, utkarsh azadi ka amrit mahotsav on 17th September 2021 on the occasion of 75 years of independence. Other important events organised by the department were “Learn with Google - a series under Career Bootcamp” (19th October, 2021) and “Learn with Bloomberg - A series under career Bootcamp” (5th November, 2021). A co-authored paper by one of the students of Business Economics Ms. Anishka Taneja has been accepted in Scopus-indexed OPEC's Official Journal, Energy Review.

The Department of Commerce organized an orientation programme for B. Com. Hons. and Prog. Students separately by Dr. Seema Sodhi, Dr. M. P. Meena and Mr. Sanjeev Kumar. The students were apprised of the functioning of the activities in the present pandemic scenario. The students of the Commerce Department actively participated in the various activities organized by the college as a part of “Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav”.The department in its departmental meeting held on 5th January 2022 in the staff room decided to organize Essay Writing, Poster Making and other competitions from January to March, 2022. It has organized a webinar on contemporary issues in the second week of March, 2022.

The Department of Economics has been organizing different events to enhance the growth and outlook of its teachers and students. The College is fully equipped with IT facilities including four computer labs, Internet access and multimedia projectors with interactive smart board. The college has high-speed Internet connectivity with 125 Mbps fiber optics provided by the University of Delhi and Airtel 4G Home WiFi connections for an official emergency etc.

Computer Labs are equipped with 10 (Ten) 5KVA and 2 (Two) 10KVA online UPS facilities with 1hrs power backup. The entire college campus is Wi-Fi enabled with

UTM Box security system. The entire college campus is covered by 62 CCTV camera networks and the Library has 26 network cameras for security of students, staff and the college with separate surveillance room.

The college has established an IT Hub including 110 computers and 02 servers with the latest configuration. The Computer labs I, II, III, and IV are equipped with Smart Board for teaching and learning of students. The college received 813 laptops for students and 20 laptops for teachers from the University of Delhi, which were subsequently distributed to the students and faculty members for their academic practical etc. To improve IT infrastructure and teaching methodology, the College has installed 22 multimedia projectors provided by Delhi University in the classrooms with an equal number of laptops to teach students through it. The college is currently in the process of making its students attendance system online.
