Notice for choice of Common Courses (GEC, for Odd Semester-III 2024{for BA (Hons) ,B Com (Hons)and BA(Prog)}).

- All Semester III students of BA (Hons) and B Com (Hons). Please note that they have to choose their Generic Elective Course (GEC), by filling a Google form, the link will open on **9 .8.24 at 7 pm** and it is attached in this form also.
- **Before that they read, understand and go through the syllabus of papers.**
- The last date for filling the Google forms is 11.8.24.

Please note the following points:

- The students should carefully fill the google form because this form can be submitted only once. Care should be taken in correctly mentioning the name, college roll number, examination roll number, e-mail id and phone number (please provide your own active phone number).
- Students must go through the Syllabi of the GE and DSE before choosing your options. Please visit the University website or contact the respective departments' TIC in case of any queries.

- Students are advised to choose their GE's and DSE's in a way such that they are able to fulfil the credit requirements .

Generic Elective (GE)/DSE Information/Guidelines:

The Generic Elective course cannot be the one offered by the student's own department(s) that is it cannot be one belonging to the student's honours or core discipline(s). For example, a History (Honours) student cannot take the Generic Elective Course offered by the Department of History. Similarly, B.Com (Honours) student cannot take the Commerce GEC.

- **Students of Semester III , For all Hons** only have the option of studying either a Generic Elective Course (GEC) or a Discipline-Specific Elective (DSE) Course offered by their parent department(s). The choice of GEC will enable the students to choose from the common pool of GEC offered in the College, whereas the choice of DSE will require the student to study the elective course(s) offered by their parent department/discipline(s). For example, a Economics(Honours) Economics student can either choose any of the common pool GE courses (excluding Economics GEC) or an elective course in Economics (DSE) offered by the Economics department.
- In case a student chooses to pursue a DSE and not a GE in Semester III, s/he can then indicate that in the form. No choice of GEC will be asked from such students. Students should carefully consider this option to choose either a DSE or a GE. The students will have a very short window to alter their preferences for DSE or GE once the semester starts. However, this will be contingent upon seat availability in particular GE courses.
