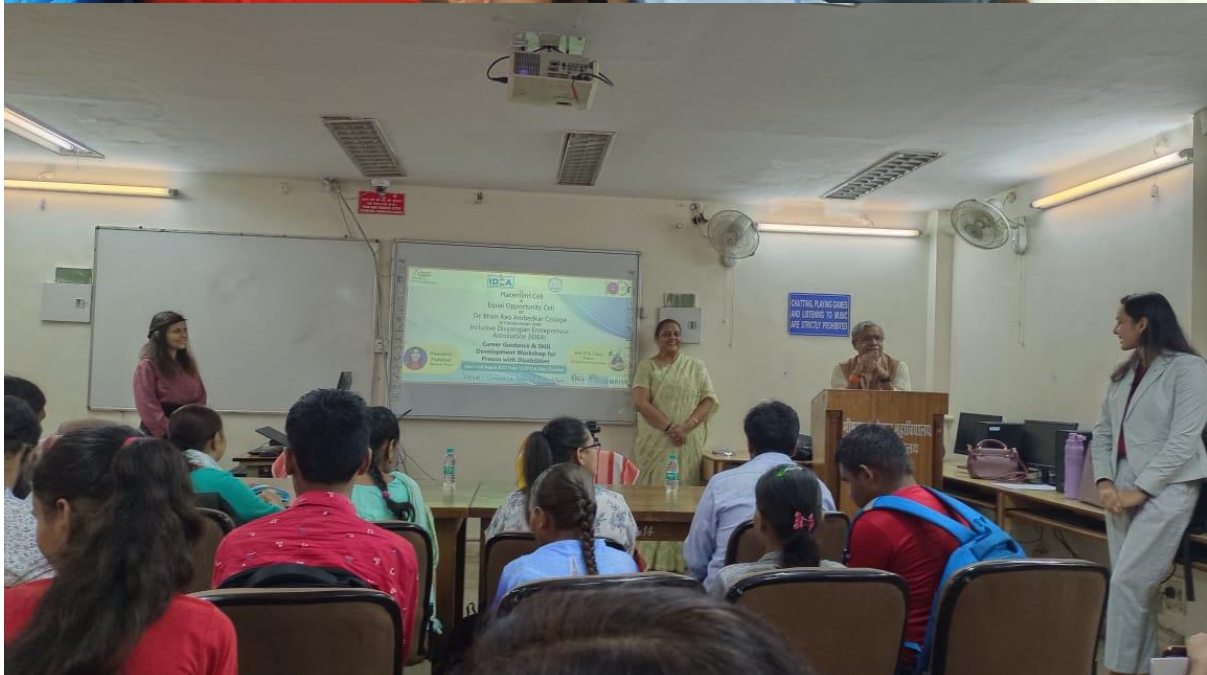

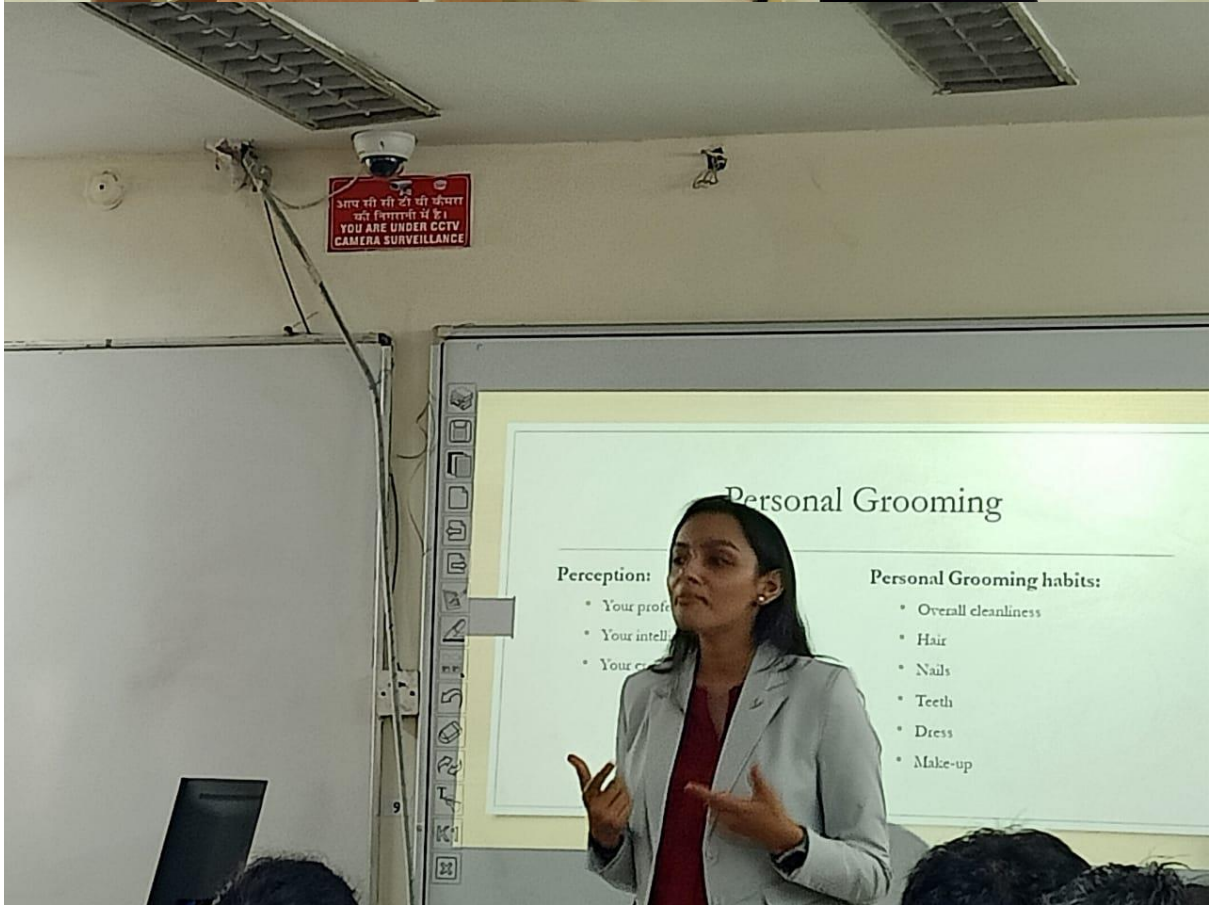

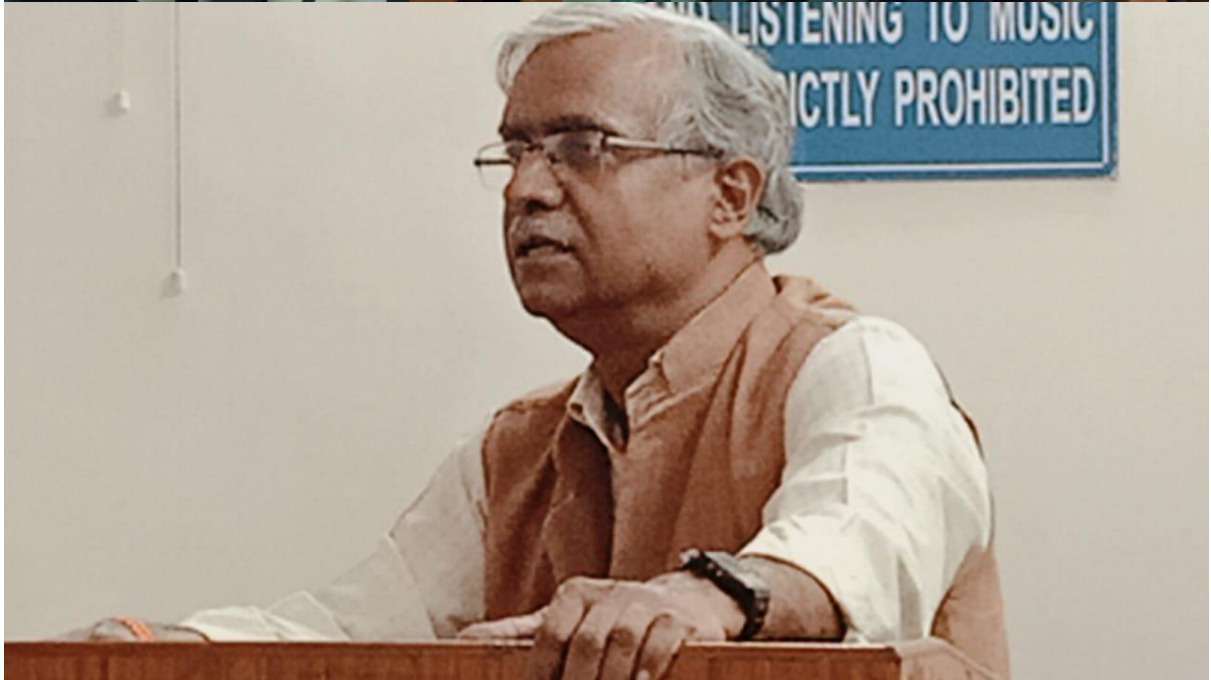

In addition, our 7 second year students were offered part time stipend-based internship by Reliance Jio.

The Placement Cell in collaboration with Inclusive Divyangjan Entrepreneur Association (IDEA) organised a career guidance & Skill Development workshop for current students and alumni with disabilities on August 2, 2022 with aim to build up work related skills of PWDs students and girls from economically weaker sections. A total of 55 participants attended the programme. The Resource person were Ms Meenakshi Mahalwal, a consultant in the corporate sector, Ms Siddhi, a practising consultant, Mr Vineet from IDEA, Ms Sakshi, the placement coordinator, IDEA. The participants were provided various tips on personal grooming and Etiquette, interpersonal skills, CV designing, Interview, Email Etiquettes, and business communication.









On 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022, The Placement Cell in coordination with Equal Opportunity Cell of the College organised INCLUSIVE MEGA JOB FAIR, with support from Samarthan Trust for the Disabled and B K Welfare Foundation in the College premises. This Job Fair was for all

graduates, Students with disabilities, alumni of various colleges and other candidates from the open community. The prospective job seekers from various parts of the country like Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, including Delhi NCR were present to avail the opportunity. A total of 21 companies were present on the campus which included Concentrix, My Money Mantra, Global Talent Training, Devyani International, RAP Info System, Muthoot Fincorp, SBI Credit Card, McDonald's, ICCS Callings, Byjus, and many more. The event witnessed an impressive registration of around 500 candidates. A total of 238 candidates were shortlisted, 11 candidates were given offer letters on the spot. Another 114 candidates were given offer letter during the one month follow up process with companies. The event was presided by Prof K.P. Singh, Director, Gandhi Study Center of University of Delhi as the Chief guest, Air Commodore Ranjan Mukherjee, the commissioner of Disability for Delhi and Mr K.K. The Placement Cell organised a two-days training programme on Business Communication, personality Development, Interview skills and life skills at workplace on 31<sup>st</sup> October and 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 in the college auditorium. On the first day, Dr. Sunita Malik, Associate Professor, Department of English conducted a session on Business Communication. This session was attended by around 120 students. On the second day, November 1<sup>st</sup>, a session on 'Life Skills at Workplace' and another on 'Interview and Soft Skills' were conducted jointly by Mrs. Raj Shree Singh and Mr. Nirbhay Sharma. Mrs. Raj Shree Singh, a Senior Consultant at Brief Private Limited and an enthusiastic professional with more than a decade of experience in training and project management, briefed about the 10 necessary life skills crucial to any workspace by giving various live examples. Mr. Nirbhay Sharma, who is teaching law and has been mentoring students for the last 15 years for facing interviews, explained in detail the nuances of interview skills, the most commonly asked questions, and the difference in preparation for a private sector and Government job. A total of 150+ students were benefitted from the session. A feedback form was also circulated to acknowledge the reviews of the students which had a positive outcome.



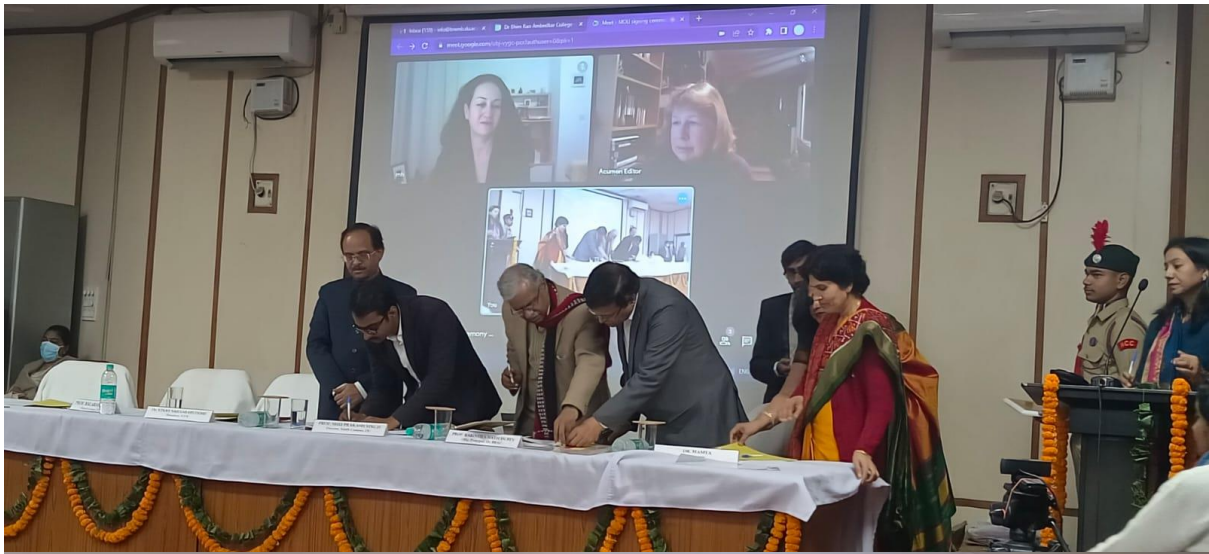
